



Jeffrey Nigro is the Director of Adult Programs in the Department of Museum Education at the Art Institute of Chicago. He received his B.A. at Oberlin College and his M.A. in art history at the University of Virginia. Jeff has been lecturing on the Art Institute's collections since 1988, and became a full-time staff lecturer in 1993, Senior Lecturer in 2000, and Director of Adult Programs in 2004. He has acted as Study Leader on Art Institute sponsored trips to Italy, Greece and Germany. In addition to lecturing at the museum, he has given pre-concert lectures for the Chicago Symphony Orchestra, both at Symphony Center and at the Ravinia Festival, and is a frequent speaker for The Jane Austen Society of North America (JASNA).
